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## **HOT CAKES** Hats



Round 4: \*(K3, p2, p2tog); repeat from \* to end of round. Round 5: \*(K3, p1, p2tog); repeat from \* to end of round. Round 6: \*(K2tog, k1, p2); repeat from \* to end of round. Round 7: \*(K2tog, p2); repeat from \* to end of round. Round 8: \*(K2tog, p1); repeat from \* to end of round. Round 9: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* to end of round. Round 10: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* to end of round.

Cut yarn, thread through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor. Weave in all ends.

Ribbed Man's Hat (Ladies on reverse) Size: To fit a man's average head.

**Materials:** 

Hot Cakes: 1-200g Cake

Shown in color 3 - Grey Burgundy Mix **Needles:** 16" size 8 needles, double pointed needles of same size, 1 stitch

marker.

**Gauge:** 18 sts = 4" over st st.

Loosely cast on 100 sts. Place a stitch marker and join, taking care not to twist. Work in \*(K3, p2) ribbing until total length is about 6.5", ending at the marker.

Begin decreasing, changing to double pointed needles when needed.

Round 1: \*(K3, p2, k2tog, k1, p2); repeat from \* to end of round.

Round 2: \*(K3, p2, k2tog, p2); repeat

from \* to end of round.

Round 3: \*(K3, p2, p2tog, p1); repeat

from \* to end of round.

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#### Ladies Hat

**Size:** To fit a Ladies average head.

Materials: 1 - 200g Cake

Shown in color 3 - Grey Burgundy Mix **Needles:** 16" size 7 & 8 needles, double pointed needles size 8, 1 stitch marker.

**Gauge:** 18 sts = 4" over st st on larger needles.

### K2/p2 ribbing

Round 1: \*(K2, p2); repeat around. Repeat round 1 for k2/p2 ribbing.

With smaller needles, loosely cast on 88 sts. Place marker and join, taking care not to twist the sts.

Work in k2/p2 ribbing for 2", increasing evenly around to 100 sts on the last round of ribbing.

Change to larger needle and work in st st until total length measures about 8", ending at the marker. Begin decreases as follows, changing to double points when needed.

Round 1: \*(K8, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (90 sts).

Round 2: Knit even.

Round 3: \*(K7, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (80 sts).

Round 4: Knit even.

Round 5: \*(K6, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (70 sts).

Round 6: \*(K5, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (60 sts).

Round 7: \*(K4, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (50 sts).

Round 8: \*(K3, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (40 sts).

Round 9: \*(K2, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (30 sts).

Round 10: \*(K1, k2tog); repeat from \* around. (20 sts).

Round 11: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around. (10 sts).

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: k = knit, k2tog= knit two sts together, p = purl, p2tog = purl 2 sts together, RS= right side, st(s) = stitch(es), WS = wrong side, yo= yarn over, ch = chain, sk = skip, dc= double crochet, st(s) = stitch(es), sp = space, m1 = make 1 st = lift bar onto needle, knit into the back of it to increase 1 st., Kf&b = knit into the front and the back of the stitch.
