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SOLSTICE Cathedral Windows Shawl



Approx. Finished After Blocking: 20x60"

Materials:

Solstice: 5 - 50g balls, shown in color 27 Orchid

Gauge: 19 sts and 22 rows = 4" in pattern **Needles:** US Size 7 knitting needles, 2 stitch markers, Tapestry needle.

Cathedral Windows Pattern

(multiples of 8 sts plus 1)

Row 1: (WS) and all other wrong-side rows-Purl.

Row 2: K1, *yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from *

Row 4: K2, *yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3; rep from * end

last repeat k2.

Row 6: P1, *k2, yo, sl 1-k2tog-psso, yo, k2, p1; rep

from *

Row 8, 10, 12, 14, and 16: P1, *ssk, (k1, yo) twice, k1,

k2tog, p1; rep from *.

Repeat rows 1-16.

NOTE: Be aware of the ending of Row 4 which is a k2, not k3 as established in the repeat.

Directions:

Cast on 91 sts. Work 3 rows of garter stitch.

Next row, knit 5 sts, pm, knit across until 5 sts

remaining, pm, knit last 5 sts.

Next row, k5, sm, start with Row 2 of Cathedral

Windows Pattern, sm, k5.

Continue working on established garter stitch edge and Cathedral Windows Pattern Stitch center, until piece

measures approximately 59" ending on Row 6 of pattern. Work 4 rows of garter stitch, removing stitch markers.

Bind off loosely. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: BO= bind off, dec= decrease, k = knit, ksp = k1, slip st back onto left hand needle, lift 2^{nd} st on left hand needle back over returned st and replace returned st on right hand needle, psso= pass slipped stitch over, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip = 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, sl(s) = slitch(es), st sl = slockinette st, sl = slockinette

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
