

**CALZASOCKS ft. KnitCol Print
Baby Jacket**



Approx. Finished Size: 18.5 (20.5, 23)".

Materials:

Calzasocks: 1 (2, 2)-100g balls, shown in color 177

Gauge: 28 sts = 4" on a US 4 needle over st st.

Needles/Notions: US 2 & 4, or size necessary to obtain given gauge, stitch markers, 3 buttons.

BACK: With smaller needles, loosely cast on 75 (83, 91) sts. Work in garter st for 10 rows. Change to larger needles and work in st st. While decreasing 1 st each side edge every 8th row 5 times total: 65 (73, 81) sts. When total length is 11 (12, 13)", ending with a WS row; Bind off.

ABBREVIATIONS: alt = alternate, bo = bind off, beg = begin(ing), CO = cast on, cont. = continue, dec = decrease, foll = following, inc = increase, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, meas = measures, pssso = pass slip stitch over, p = purl, patt = pattern, PU = pick up, RS = right side, rem = remain(ing), sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over.

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RIGHT FRONT: With smaller needles, loosely cast on 38 (42, 46) sts. Work in garter st for 10 rows. Until neck shaping: Keep 5 sts at beginning of every RS row in garter st (knit these sts on WS rows as well). Change to larger needles and work in st st (with garter border) while at the same time decreasing 1 st at the end of a RS row every 8th row 5 times total: 33 (37, 41) sts. Continue even in st st (with garter border) until total length is 8 (9, 10)”, ending with a WS row. Stop Garter st border now. Shape neck: BO 4 (5, 6) sts at the beginning of the next row. Dec 1 st at the neck edge of the next 5(5, 6) rows, then every following alternate row until 21 (23, 25) sts remain. Continue even until same length as the Back. Bind off.

LEFT FRONT: With smaller needles, loosely cast on 38 (42, 46) sts. Work in garter st for 10 rows. Until neck shaping: Keep 5 sts at end of every RS row in garter st (knit these sts on WS rows as well). Change to larger needles and work in st st (with garter border) while at the same time decreasing 1 st at the beginning of a RS row every 8th row 5 times total: 33 (37, 41) sts. Continue even in st st (with garter border) until total length is 8 (9, 10)”, ending with a RS row. Stop Garter st border now. Shape neck: BO 4 (5, 6) sts at the beginning of the next row. Dec 1 st at the neck edge of the next 5(5, 6) rows, then every following alternate row until 21 (23, 25) sts remain. Continue even until same length as the Back. Bind off.

SLEEVES: With smaller needles, loosely cast on 41 (43, 45) sts. Work in Garter st for for 8 rows, increasing 4 stitches evenly across the last row of ribbing: 45 (47, 49) sts. Change to larger needles and work in st st.

AT THE SAME TIME: Begin increasing 1 st at each end of 5th and every following 6th row until there are 57 (61, 65) sts. Work even until total length is 6½(7½, 8½)”, ending with a WS row. Bind off loosely.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder seams together. With smaller needles, pick up and knit 77 (82, 87) sts around neck. Work in garter st for 8 rows. Bind off loosely. Sew in sleeves, and sew up side seams.

Button Band (left front for Girl, right front for boy)

With smaller needle, and RS facing, pick up 61 (69, 77) sts along appropriate front edge. Work in garter st for 7 rows. Bind off neatly.

Buttonhole Band (right front for Girl, left front for boy): With smaller needle, and RS facing, pick up 61(69, 77) sts along appropriate front edge. Work in garter st for 3 rows. Buttonhole row: Knit, working 3 button holes in top 4” of garment by working yo, k2tog for each buttonhole. Place top one along neck band area, bottom one at 4” from top edge mark, and middle one half way inbetween. Work in garter st for 3 more rows. Bind off neatly in ribbing. Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes. Weave in all ends.

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
