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# HEARTY HOMESTEAD TWEED Striped Throw



**Size:** Approx 35" x 42"

Materials: Hearty Homestead Tweed: 4 – 100g hanks, color 712 Spruce and 2 – 100g hanks, color 704 Light Grey Size: Approx 35" x 42" Needles: 24" size 10.5 needle Gauge: 3 sts = 1" over st st.

Abbreviations: K = knit; P = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); garter st = knit every row; st st = stockinette stitch = knit the RS rows, purl the WS rows; RS = right side; WS = wrong side.

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#### **Begin:**

With Spruce, loosely cast on 105 sts. Knit 18 rows.

Begin pattern of stockinette stitch with 10 st garter st border on each side as follows:
RS rows: K10, k85, k10.
WS rows: K10, p85, k10.
Work in stockinette with Garter st borders while working the stripes as follows:
With Spruce- work 6 rows in pattern.
With Grey- work 10 rows in pattern.

# Measure at this point. Make note of <u>exactly</u> how many inches you have at this point. Call this measurement "X"

With Spruce- work in pattern until total length equals 42" – "X". End with a WS row.

Then reverse the striping as follows: With Grey- work 10 rows in pattern. With Spruce- work 6 rows in pattern.

With Grey- work 10 rows in pattern. With Spruce- work 6 rows in pattern. With Grey- work 10 rows in pattern. With Spruce- work 6 rows in pattern.

Continuing with Spruce- work 18 rows of garter st. Bind off loosely. Weave in all ends. Dampen the garter stitch edges to block them flat if desired.

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
