

Bi-USE Scarf



Scarf Size: 52" x 7"

**Gauge: 7 sts and 7 rows= 4" in Pattern
Stitch**

Materials:

Bi-Use (50g) - 3 skeins

**Needles: US size 17 knitting needles or size to
obtain gauge.**

Uniqueness:

This yarn contains thick loops and plain loops.
In this pattern every other row the needle is
inserted into the plain loop which will be called
the Elongated Stitch. Using the whole strand
will be referred to as the Bulk Stitch.

Directions:

Cast on 12 sts with full strand.

Work 2 rows of Garter Stitch using Bulk Stitch.

Row1: Work garter st the Elongated Stitch look
described above.

Row 2: Work garter stitch using Bulk Stitch.

Repeat these 2 rows until scarf measures
approximately 50", or until almost out of yarn..

Work 2 rows of Garter Stitch using Bulk Stitch.
Bind off loosely.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

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
