

PERLINA
Striped Baby Hat



The matching cardigan (Plymouth pattern 2970) photographed on the baby is a great way to use up small yarn amounts.

The cardigan has an intarsia rose design that coordinates with the hats colors.

To Fit Size:
Preemie, (Newborn, 3 mths, 6 mths)
Approximate Circumference:
11 ¼, (12 ½, 13 ½, 15 ¾)

Materials

Perlina:

1—50G ball, color 18 Red

Less than 50G of each:

1 White, 2 Pink, 3 Lt Blue, 18 Teal

Gauge: 32 sts, 42 rows= 4” in st st on US Size 2 (2.75mm) *after blocking,*

Needles/Notions: US Size 1 (2.25mm) and 2 (2.75mm) DPNs, 1 st marker (m), tapestry needle.

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one

number is given, it applies to all sizes.

Begin

With Red and smaller DPNs, CO 90, (99, 108, 126) sts. divide them between 3 of the DPNs. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist. PM. Work ¾” in garter st (k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd), end having worked a k rnd. Switch to larger needle. Then, work 6, (6, 7, 7) rnds of each color in this sequence:

Pink, White, Teal, White, Lt Blue, White, Red, White. Rep the sequence as necessary.

At the same time when hat measures 4 ½”, (5, 5½, 6) from CO edge, shape crown as follows:

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: *K 7, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: *K 6, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: *K 5, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 4: *K 4, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 5: *K 3, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 6: *K 2, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 7: *K 1, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 8: *K2tog; rep from * around.

Cut yarn, leaving a 4” tail. Thread tapestry needle through rem sts. Pull tightly and fasten off the top of the hat. Weave in all ends.

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
